## 2008 PREFERRED DRUG LIST

Choice Pharmacy lets you, physicians and pharmacists choose medications that work best for you. Following is a list of commonly used drugs covered by your plan. This list is not all inclusive. Please refer to the Web site listed on your member ID card for access to information on all available drugs. When you use these preferred drugs, you get the most out of your pharmacy benefit while keeping costs to a minimum.

Your health plan covers prescription drugs at three levels. The amount you pay out of pocket depends on the tier from which you and your physician select your medication. If your physician prescribes a drug, it's a good idea to ask if a less expensive, appropriate and equally effective drug is available.

Since there may be more than one drug appropriate for your condition, we encourage you to use generic or preferred brand-name drugs when possible to help manage your prescription costs. If you request a brand-name drug when a generic equivalent is available, you must purchase the generic drug, or pay 100 percent of the difference between the brand-name and generic price, plus either the generic or brand-name

copy, depending on your plan. Please refer to your Summary Plan Description for details on your specific plan.

### IMPORTANT NOTE

Some plans may not cover some types of drugs, such as contraceptives and infertility and weight loss medication, even though they may appear on this list. Some plans may cover some types of drugs, such as diabetic drugs or injectable drugs, at different benefit levels. Please refer to your Summary Plan Description for details on your specific plan, including drugs that are covered or not covered, drugs that require prior authorization, and quantity limits. You may be required to satisfy a deductible (separate from your health plan deductible) before your copay takes effect.

<b>Tier 3</b> Nonpreferred brand-name drugs	\$\$\$	Highest cost, which means your share of the cost will also be higher
